Governor's Project

Hi everyone! I am extremely excited to announce the Governor's Service Project – Brick x Brick (fundraising based) and Mental Health (service based)! Below are descriptions of Brick x Brick and Mental Health:

Brick x Brick

Brick x Brick is an initiative that is to bring help to families in the African nation of Côte d'Ivoire. The main objective is to raise money to build classrooms for children in Côte d'Ivoire. It's also a way to give women a chance to be educated as teachers. The bricks used to build the classrooms are recycled which means that this project is also environmentally friendly! This project supports childhood development, environmental justice, food insecurity, and homelessness. 284 classrooms have already been built and 91 are under construction which means many young kids, especially girls, will receive an education. Through various fundraising and donations we can help provide soap, backpacks, school supplies, and even a latrine stall.

Mental Health

Mental health is an important area to focus on because it is sometimes overlooked. This is crucial to take care of, especially as college students who are extremely busy. Bad mental health can cause problems in relationships, hinder academic performance, and physiologically too. This is why mental health will be centered in on as one of the District Initiatives. Previously, in support of organizations mission of mental health, New Jersey District put together and shipped out Mental Health Care Packages for College students throughout the District, to support them as they pursue their higher education goals.

K-Fam Picnic Sneak Peek

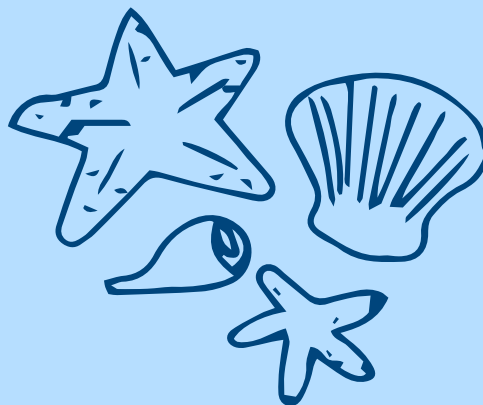

Club Officer Training Conference (COTC) Recap

COTC, or the Club Officer Training Conference, marks the initial gathering for club officers at the onset of the service year. It serves as their introduction to the District Board and an opportunity to connect with fellow club officers from across New Jersey. The session began with an overview of the District Board's role and how we can support club officers. Following this, participants broke off into smaller groups tailored to their respective officer roles. As the District Treasurer, I took charge of hosting a specialized "Treasurers Training" session for club treasurers. During this session, I outlined my expectations for treasurers and provided an overview of their responsibilities, with a focus on managing dues. I offered advice on effectively pitching the importance of paying dues to their clubs and encouraged treasurers to brainstorm specific incentives tailored to their clubs' needs. Through interactive exercises, treasurers had the chance to practice their pitching skills and share insights with the whole group.

After the breakouts, we reconvened for presentations on Membership Benefits, Retention & Growth, Service Projects, and our International Service Initiatives, with an emphasis on Brick x Brick. These sessions provided club officers with a better understanding of how to grow their clubs and how to incentivize them to stay with CKI. It also gave them a better understanding of our organization on a District and International level. My favorite part about COTC was meeting all the club treasurers face-to-face and learning about them on a personal level. COTC plays a very crucial role in creating a strong connection between the club officers and the district board at the beginning of the service year.

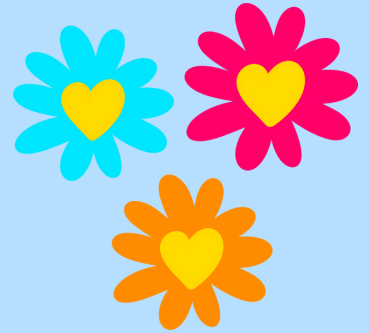

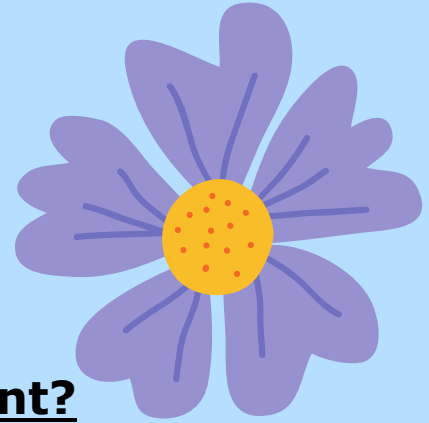
