#### **General Reminders**

District Governor Dylan provided general reminders regarding voting processes during board meetings, emphasizing the importance of being more communicative since communication has been lacking in the past couple of months, and completing directives on a monthly basis. In more detail, only executive board members and lieutenant governors can vote in the voting processes. Directives should also be done promptly and checked off on the spreadsheet.

### Cirkling Reminders and Overview

District Editor Moira reminded the board to chip in any Cirkling assignments in the Google Sheet. She will send the assignments out every two months with reminders to follow each one. All board members will be notified a month in advance when assignments are out.

#### **Voucher Reminder and Overview**

District Treasurer Julia reminded the board how to do the vouchers process. She went over how to fill one out and went over what is vouchable for the year. Some important notes include mileage can be vouched one way, send a digital receipt if something is purchased online, and to always sign off on the voucher at the bottom.

### Service Hours and Report Form Overview

District Secretary Samuel went over how to track service and administrative hours. He went over how the spreadsheet functioned and went over some guidelines on what counted as service or administrative hours. He emphasized to utilize this month by month to stay organized on report forms.

#### International Convention Recap

Garden LTG Shayna stated ICON 2025 was so fun and had the chance to meet people from other districts and countries. Her workshop with Dylan was a success, and had people come to them afterwards for advice. Seabreeze LTG Jake seconded all of Shayna's comments. He added that he and Conventions and Conferences Chair Aeryn were selected to go to the Nest Up Program. Aeryn stated that she found the program useful and will apply what she learned in her leadership role. District Governor Dylan echoed that ICON offered a variety of speakers, workshops, and activities in the city of Pittsburgh. He encouraged the board to apply for international awards when they open up again.

## Club Building Updates

Garden LTG Shayna stated he is prioritizing in chartering Ocean County College, Rutgers Camden, Rowan College at Burlington County, and Rowan College of South Jersey. Seabreeze LTG Jake is focusing on helping Brookdale Community College and looking to charter Princeton University. Metro LTG Brandon is looking to charter Kean University, Raritan Community College, St. Peter's University, and Warren Community College. Laws, Regulations, and Awards Chair Anthony mentioned he has a couple contacts at a few of these listed schools to see if they are interested in starting up a CKI club. District Administrator Joey added that members can be a part of a CKI club as long as they are on that campus.

#### **DCON Hotel Discussion**

District Governor Dylan introduced three potential hotels for DCON 2026. The options are the Clarion Hotel in Toms River, the APA Hotel Woodbridge in Iselin, and the Sheraton Edison Hotel. The final decision on which hotel to use will be discussed at a future board meeting.

This is a day where the clubs in the division come together at one location to service and fellowship while meeting other people from other clubs. The LTGs will have more details on this rolling out.

District Governor Dylan is planning to have a Winter Social around the first weekend of February. More details will be coming soon in regards of what members want to see.

#### Insight/DCON Plans

Conventions and Conferences Chair Aeryn gave a detailed month by month breakdown of the execution of how the planning of Insight would occur. More information regarding the registration prices and deadlines will be announced soon in the coming weeks.

Kiwanis Family and Alumni Relations Chair Leo went over information regarding the 2025 K-Fam Picnic.
